

2026–27 JH FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS

At the first rodeo, turn in a \$600 post-dated check dated December 1, 2026, to Region 1 when you check in for your back number and raffle tickets. *Write the member's name in the Memo section of the check.* **You may also send your fundraising check with your entries for the first rodeo if you would like.**

Fundraising checks will **not** be cashed until December 1, 2026, giving you time to sell tickets before the \$600 check is deposited.

When possible, ask buyers to make raffle ticket checks payable to you. If a check is made payable to Region 1, I will endorse it and return it to you.

All ticket stubs and ad(s) are due by November 7, 2026, the last rodeo of the fall.

If you plan to continue selling extra raffle tickets after November 7, 2026, please notify Marcy. Extra raffle ticket stubs must be turned in no later than March 6, 2027 at the first spring rodeo.

To meet the \$600 fundraising requirement, you must sell the following tickets and ad:

- Sell one (1) \$50 State Ad (\$50). This amount is included in the \$600 check you turn in at the first rodeo. You may sell the ad and reimburse yourself, use it for your own business, or use it as a good-luck ad for your contestant.
- Sell three (3) \$50 Bloomer Trailer tickets (\$150).
For every three tickets sold, you will receive one free ticket.
- Sell fifty (50) \$5 Region 1 Cash Raffle tickets (\$250).
- *Sell fifteen (15) \$10 Ford Truck tickets (\$150).
For every five tickets sold, you will receive one free ticket.

*Additional Ford Truck Raffle Information:

Tickets may be sold only by TJHRA members or individuals authorized by TJHRA.

Tickets will cost \$10.00 per ticket. Each TJHRA member is expected to sell a minimum of 15 tickets.

The top-selling TJHRA member in each region will receive **\$250**, provided the member sells at least 50 tickets.

The top-selling region will receive **\$1,000**. The second- and third-place regions will each receive **\$500**. Awards will be calculated based on the number of members in each region. In the event of a tie, the prize money will be split.

The raffle may not be promoted through paid advertising.

The raffle drawing will be held at the THSRA State Finals in Abilene on June 12, 2027.

The truck winner is responsible for all vehicle tax, title, license, transfer costs, and any other taxes, including income tax. The winner must accept the truck as is and keep the advertising on the truck for at least one (1) year from the delivery date.
